After receiving suggestions via email from the committee members as to what questions the agencies should be asked, Chairman Beyer will create a checklist that will be sent to the members by March 30<sup>th</sup>. She will also contact the agencies to give them a heads up.

When asked about the visits, Supervisor Bruderle stated that the agency visits are a legitimate way to gather information about the agencies, and the agencies will want to show the committee members what they do to help seniors. The visits will also be a way to learn more about gaps in services and what is needed to help the agencies meet needs better. Additionally, committee members may share any concerns with the agencies.

To give them a more complete understanding, newer committee members who were not part of last year's funding process will receive copies of the proposals of the agencies that they will be visiting.

Discussion was held regarding the Township's emerging lending closet and the upcoming mental health first aid course and museum tour, as well as the reoccurring efforts to find out from seniors where gaps and cracks in services are. Also, the Township is opening up the Senior's Social Café as a socializing opportunity for seniors. All of these are being promoted via social media and fliers.

Carl Strathmann spoke about the Zoom call that he and Supervisor Bruderle sat in on regarding senior transportation and Pace and said that Pace is not adequately flexible. Supervisor Bruderle brought up the Transportation Posse that he is exploring forming.
